In addition, you will work as a Business Analyst who works with the new cloud services Product roadmap to develop the Product Requirements Document (PRD) and socializes the PRD with the developers to executive against the PRD and roadmap. You will be responsible for

process flows, requirements, test plans, and working with the product team to develop user reference materials.

What you do daily:

Project Management Responsibilities

- Develop a detailed project plan to monitor and track progress. Develop spreadsheets, diagrams and process maps to document needs and updates on projects
- Work with all project stakeholders to drive towards timely milestone completion, primary point of contact for project status and updates
- Host regular meetings with teams to drive project completion
- Prepare executive level presentations or written reports. Report and escalate to management as needed
- Coordinate internal resources and third parties/vendors for the flawless execution of projects
- Establish and maintain relationships with third parties/vendors

Business Analyst Responsibilities

- Act as liaison between Development Team and Cloud Business unit, providing a single point of contact between the two organizations
- Lead development discussions between Business Units to finalize expected deliverables
- Assist user community in analyzing and defining needs; creating detailed specifications from which development projects will be written
- Reviews and edits requirements, specifications, business processes and recommendations related to proposed solution
- Oversee implementation of new functionality and keep business owners updated with project progress
- Track End-to-End Testing and facilitate User Acceptance Testing to validate all defined requirements are met
- Identify required changes and communicate necessary changes to development team
- Create, document, update, and communicate on any new development or process changes

- 3+ years' experience working experience in project management in telephony, software, IT or equivalent a technical environment. Experience working in the Cloud space is a plus
